

UNIVERSAL WALL TENT

Perfect living quarters, the Universal Wall Tent has extra height in the center ridge and walls for head room and clearance for bunks. Heavy duty wood poles and stakes included. Rugged Army Khaki Cotton Duck fabric is standard as well as split corners for wall roll-up.

For longer wear and insulation, a fly is recommended. The fly (shown) extends beyond perimeter for weather resistance and natural cooling. Fly is made of 13 oz. White or Green vinyl laminated polyester.

WOODSMAN SUPREME WALL TENT

This is an excellent multi-purpose camping tent. The Woodsman Supreme boasts simplicity and space. Set-up is a breeze with only a ridge and two upright poles, Polypro ropes and stakes. Corners are split for walls to roll up. Front and rear doors offer ventilation. Fabric is 13 oz. Polaris with several color choices available. Optional screens (shown), fly and floor are also available.

CHARACTERISTICS OF TENT FABRICS

Tent City tents perform best when well maintained and used properly. The finest finishes and treatments available have been used to ensure strong color retention and the best possible resistance to water, mildew, and flame. However, due to varying climatic conditions, this does not constitute a guarantee.

MILDEW - If detected, brush off immediately. Regardless of treatment, there is no way to absolutely stop the fungus growth if it is prevalent in your area. No tent can be guaranteed not to mildew. Be sure the tent is dry and stored in a cool, dry place.

WATER RESISTANCE -No tent fabric can be guaranteed absolutely waterproof. Initial leakage will occur at seams or at an occasional pinhole. It usually requires exposure to dampness and several rains before slight leakage is minimized or eliminated. Such exposure tends to allow thread, fabric and stitching to swell.

FLAME RESISTANCE - All fabrics used in the production of camp tents are flame resistant and are labeled according to government specifications. Denoted with FR.

FADING- Variable sun conditions, exposures, types of materials and finishes all influence color retention of fabrics. Consequently, tent fabrics cannot be guaranteed against fading.

DESCRIPTION OF MATERIALS

All fabrics below are flame, mildew, and water resistant.

- 13 oz. Army Khaki Excellent material, closely woven, high tear resistance, strong construction, 100% cotton
- 13 oz. Vinyl Laminated Polyester Easy to clean, yet durable with strong tear and tensile strength
- 13 oz. Polaris 50/50 Blend Cotton & Polyester Low cost, superior to drills, light weight, easy to handle
- 11 oz. Cotton Duck with Excello Finish 100% cotton, closely woven
- Screen Charcoal fiberglass screen, keeps most insects out
- FR FR denotes Flame Resistance

ELECTRONIC WELDING

Welding or heat sealing widths of certain vinyl fabrics is recommended for certain fabrications depending on end use. Tent City is equipped to perform this service as required for fabrication.



WARNING

Although many Tent City products are manufactured to meet certain code requirements, the majority of our products do not meet structural code. If you are interested in certification to meet a particular wind load, please contact us and specify your need. Nearly all of our products are manufactured for use as temporary shade structures; therefore, for the safety of all occupants, evacuation is recommended if threatening or severe weather occurs or if there is any doubt concerning the safe use of this product.

CAUTION

1. For each installation, the installer is solely responsible for evaluating the site and the proper securing method. Some soils require different staking or securing than that provided with the tent. Due to the variety of soil conditions, installers should use caution when tensioning out the tent. Tent City's responsibility is limited to the construction of the tent. We are not responsible for methods that installers may choose to secure the tent to the ground.

- 2. As much as the weather is unpredictable, good judgement and common sense must be incorporated with installation guidelines. It is the responsibility of the tent installer/maintainer to determine the severity of the weather, proper time and method of installation and/or erection and disassembly. Evacuation of the tent is recommended at any time weather becomes threatening or there is any doubt concerning the safe use of this product. A successful event is a safe event.
- 3. Proper safety equipment should be used at all times to ensure safe installation and take-down. We suggest a careful evaluation be made to determine safety equipment needed, such as hard hat, steel-toed shoes, safety glasses and other as required.
